On this first Sunday of Lent the response we give to the psalm is:

"The people that follow you believe your ways are truth and love."

Help us to show your truth and love to other people, by our actions to show we are your followers.





## **Monday 19th February**

At this time there are so many places in the world with war and conflict. Take time today to pray for peace throughout the world.

# Tuesday 20th February

Pray the prayer that Jesus himself taught us, the Our Father, and think carefully about each line. "Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name ....."





#### Wednesday 21st February

We have many challenges in our life. We have crosses to carry. Jesus carried his cross to Golgotha and took our sins with him. Jesus fell and got up and carried on. Pray for the strength to carry on when you have problems.

## Thursday 22nd February

Today is the Feast of St Peter's Chair.

"Grant, we pray, almighty God, that no tempests may disturb us, for you have set us fast on the rock of the Apostle Peter's confession of faith."

#### Friday 23rd February

So many people in the world do not have enough to eat and no clean water to drink. CAFOD supports many people throughout the world. Make a donation to CAFOD—even a few pence can make a different. Or maybe give some money to another charity you know that helps people.

#### Saturday 24th February

What are you good at? What gifts has God given you? Use your God given gifts to help someone today. A small act can make a big difference to somebody.





#### **Sunday 25th February**

In the Gospel reading today the disciples Peter, John and James see Jesus's transfiguration. God speaks to the disciples. "This is my Son, The Chosen One. Listen to him." Pray today to be able to truly listen to Jesus.

### **Monday 26th February**

There are times in our lives when we do not know which path to take. Ask the Lord to show you the right way. Let the Lord lead you down the right road.





### Tuesday 27th February

It is easy to follow everyone else; to copy what they do. Before you do something ask God for help. Pray to make the right choice and not to just follow the crowd.

### Wednesday 28th February

In the Deaf Community we sign to communicate. It is the language of the Deaf Community. We all sign in church Deaf and hearing alike. We make the sign of the cross. Start each day making the sign of the cross.





## Thursday 29th February

The liturgical colour during Lent and Advent is violet. This is the colour symbolising suffering and sadness. Lent and Advent are the seasons of penance and preparation.

Take this opportunity to go to confession before to Easter comes. Many churches offer extra opportunities at this time of year.

# Friday 1st March

Today is St David's Day. Pray for any friends or family you may have in Wales. Remember also the Welsh Assembly and those in public office in Wales.





### Saturday 2nd March

Our world is a beautiful gift from God. Creation is amazing. Look at God's creation; a tree, flower or animal and thank God for this wonderful world that he has given us.

#### Sunday 3rd March

The Stations of the Cross take us along Jesus's road to Golgotha. If you cannot visit your local church to look at the Stations of the Cross try and imagine it. What did that road to Golgotha look like? Imagine what it would have been like to be Simon of Cyrene or Veronica.

## Saturday 9th March

Light a candle or look at an icon picture. Relax in God's love and feel his presence.





# Sunday 10th March

Mothering Sunday; a time to remember our mothers and thank God for them. Mary is Mother to us all so we join in prayer with her as we pray "Hail Mary, full of grace ...."

Today we remember the people of Ireland and St Patrick. Pray for the people of Ireland, their government and all those who have friends and family in Ireland.






## Monday 18th March
