

### Isaiah 60 1-6 Ephesians 3:2-3, 5-12 Matthew 2:1-12

Jesus was born in Bethlehem during the time when King Herod ruled. The wise men saw a star and came from the East. They asked, 'Where is the baby born to be king of the Jews? We saw his star when it came up in the East and we have come to worship him.' When King Herod heard this he was very worried. All the people in Jerusalem were worried too. King Herod had a meeting with all the Jewish priests and scribes (writers). He asked, 'Where will the baby be born?' They replied, 'In Bethlehem because in the scriptures (Bible), the prophet wrote: "A leader will come from Bethlehem and he will shepherd my people Israel." Then King Herod asked to see the wise men privately. He wanted to know the exact date when they first saw the star. Then he sent the wise men to Bethlehem, telling them, 'Go, look carefully for the baby, and when you have found him, let me know so I can come to worship him.' The wise men went on their journey and again they saw the star. They were filled with joy. They followed it and the star stopped over the place where the baby was. They went into the place and they saw the baby with his Mother Mary, then they knelt down and worshipped him. They gave him gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. But in a dream, they received a warning not to go back to king Herod; they went home a different way.
