- 40 Signed or Interpreted Masses
- supported 8 priests with their signing skills
- 5 seminarians have received training in basic BSL and liturgical signing
- 45 people attended Deaf Awareness sessions and 8 took part in a BSL taster course
- 340 Signs of Hope counselling sessions took place
- Over 1860 followers on social media for Caritas Deaf Service and close to 1100 for Signs of Hope
- Distance travelled > 2600 miles (the distance from Westminster Cathedral to Paphos)

We continue to be very thankful in the many ways the team of clergy who sign and who work with the Deaf Community and the Deaf Service staff support us. We are truly grateful for all you do.



Deaf Awareness and BSL Sessions




We have continued to use the website and social media to share pictures and videos including our bible studies and Jubilee resources.
